## ORDINANCE NUMBER 04-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF FINGERPRINT AND CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR CITY EMPLOYEES OR VOLUNTEERS INVOLVED IN YOUTH PROGRAMS

Be it ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona:

## Section 1. FINGERPRINT AND CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS

Each current and prospective paid or unpaid youth coach and/or instructor associated with the City of Maricopa, Arizona shall submit a full set of fingerprints to the City. These fingerprints shall be used to obtain a state and federal criminal records check as provided in A.R.S. §41-1750 and Public Law 92-544. Any person applying for a position as a coach or instructor, through their application and by their submission of a fingerprint set, grants the City or its designees the right to conduct such a background check and further grants the right to the City to share, without restriction, the information received with the Maricopa Police Department, the Arizona Department of Public Safety, the Federal Bureau of Investigation or any other law enforcement agency. The City further authorizes the Arizona Department of Public Safety to exchange this fingerprint data with the Federal Bureau of Investigation or any other law enforcement agency.

## Section 2. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

## Section 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas the immediate operation of the provisions of this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council of the City of Maricopa.
