

ORDINANCE NUMBER 06-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE "PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA" BY REFERENCE AS CHAPTER 17 OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, that certain document known as the Park Rules and Regulations of the City of Maricopa was adopted as a public record by Resolution No. 06-24 on June 20, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa believe, after consultation with its staff and upon public hearing, that adopting the Park Rules and Regulations of the City of Maricopa would be in the best interest of the City of Maricopa, and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §9-802 allows a City to adopt a public record by Ordinance as a means to reduce publication costs while ensuring that the public gets fair notice and opportunity to review its operative provisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 9-802, that certain document known as the "PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA," three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution No.06-24 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance.


SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict between other City Ordinances and this Ordinance (and the Code enacted hereby), this Ordinance shall be deemed to be controlling; provided, however, that this Ordinance is not intended to amend or repeal any existing City Ordinance, Resolution or regulation except as expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its adoption.




