

ORDINANCE NUMBER 09-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, ADOPTING "ARTICLE 22 – SIGN PROVISIONS" BY REFERENCE AS ARTICLE 22 OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA ZONING CODE AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, that certain document known as Article 22 – Sign Provisions was adopted as part of the City Code by Ordinance 04-02 on June 1, 2004 and amended by Ordinance 05-06 on July 12, 2005;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, have reviewed Article 22 of the City of Maricopa Zoning Code concerning the regulation of the erection and maintenance of signs within the City of Maricopa; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa believe, after consultation with its staff, that revising the City of Maricopa Sign Provisions would be in the best interest of the City of Maricopa; and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. Arizona Revised Statute Section 9-802 allows a City to adopt a public record by Ordinance as a means to reduce publication costs while ensuring that the public gets fair notice and opportunity to review its operative provisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 9-802, that certain document known as "ARTICLE 22 – SIGN PROVISIONS," three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 09-57 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance.


SECTION 2. ARTICLE 22 of the City of Maricopa Zoning Code, entitled Sign Provisions, and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with "Article 22 – Sign Provisions," which was made a public record by Resolution No. 09-57 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of adoption by the City Council for the City of Maricopa.




