

ORDINANCE NO. 10-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, ADOPTING "CHAPTER 19 GRAFFITI" BY REFERENCE AS SECTIONS 19-1 THROUGH 19-41 OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE AND REPEALING ARTICLE 10-2 OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, that certain document known as "Chapter 19 Graffiti" was adopted as a public record by Resolution No. 10-13 on April 6, 2010;

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2004, the City of Maricopa adopted a graffiti code as part of the City Code;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa believe, after consultation with its staff, that adopting Chapter 19 and repealing Article 10-2 would be in the best interest of the City of Maricopa; and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §9-802 allows a City to adopt a public record by Ordinance as a means to reduce publication costs while ensuring that the public gets fair notice and opportunity to review its operative provisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 9-802, that certain document known as "CHAPTER 19 GRAFFITI" of the Maricopa City Code, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 10-13 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Article 10-2 of the Maricopa City Code, entitled Graffiti, and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with Chapter 19 Graffiti which was made public record by Resolution No. 10-13 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona.


SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of adoption by the City Council for the City of Maricopa.




