ORDINANCE NUMBER 11-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE BY INSERTING SECTION 2-77 (D)(17) AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2004, the City of Maricopa adopted Chapter 2 Mayor and Council as part of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2009, the Mayor and City Council adopted Ordinance 09-10 amending Chapter 2 Mayor and Council as part of the City Code;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa believe, after consultation with its staff, that amending Chapter 2 by inserting Section 2-77 (d)(17) would be in the best interest of the City of Maricopa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the following language be inserted as Section 2(d)(17) of the Maricopa City Code:

Approval of actions related to the employment, suspension, or removal of the city manager.

SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict between other City Ordinances and this Ordinance, this Ordinance shall be deemed to be controlling; provided, however, that this Ordinance is not intended to amend or repeal any existing City Ordinance, Resolution or regulation except as expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of adoption by the City Council for the City of Maricopa.
