

ORDINANCE NUMBER 11-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA RELATING TO THE PRIVILEGE LICENSE TAX; ADOPTING "THE 2011 AMENDMENTS TO THE TAX CODE OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA" BY REFERENCE; ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

WHEREAS, that certain document known as The 2011 Amendments to the Tax Code of the City of Maricopa was adopted as a public record by Resolution No. 11-56 on September 20, 2011;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa believe, after consultation with its staff, that adopting The 2011 Amendments to the Tax Code of the City of Maricopa would be in the best interest of the City of Maricopa, and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. '9-802 allows a City to adopt a public record by Ordinance as a means to reduce publication costs while ensuring that the public gets fair notice and opportunity to review its operative provisions.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That certain document known as "THE 2011 AMENDMENTS TO THE TAX CODE OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA," three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, which document was made public record by Resolution 11-56 of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Any person found guilty of violating any provision of these amendments to the tax code shall be guilty of a class one misdemeanor. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offense.


SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance or any part of these amendments to the tax code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. The provisions of section 1 of this ordinance shall be effective from and after June 1, 2011. The provisions of section 2 through 5 of this ordinance shall be effective from and after July 29, 2010. The provisions of section 6 of this ordinance shall be effective from and after May 1, 2010. The provisions of section 7 of this ordinance

shall be effective from and after September 30, 2009.
