

ORDINANCE NUMBER 13-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTION 2-34(e) OF THE MARICOPA CITY CODE REGARDING THE STATE OF THE CITY ADDRESS AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2004, the City of Maricopa adopted Chapter 2 Mayor and Council as part of the City Code, which was amended on November 30, 2009 by Ordinance 09-10 and on September 4, 2012 by Ordinance 12-08; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa believe, after consultation with its staff, that amending Chapter 2 by striking the language in Section 2-34(e) in its entirety and adopting substitute language would be in the best interest of the City of Maricopa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the language contained in Section 2-34(e) of the Maricopa City Code regarding providing an annual State of the City Address and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

(e) Provide an annual State of the City Address at a time and place to be determined by the mayor.


SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict between other City Ordinances and this Ordinance, this Ordinance shall be deemed to be controlling; provided, however, that this Ordinance is not intended to amend or repeal any existing City Ordinance, Resolution or regulation except as expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of adoption by the City Council for the City of Maricopa.
