ORDINANCE NO. 13-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, SPECIFYING THE NUMBER OF SIGNATURES REQURIED ON NOMINATION PETITIONS FOR THE OFFICES OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Legislature has provided an alternative method for calculation of the number of signatures required on nomination petitions for the office of mayor and council at the City nonpartisan elections; and

WHEREAS, the City has consolidated its elections with the State election cycle pursuant to A.R.S. §16-204 as amended by the Arizona State Legislature in 2012 resulting in a potential significant increase in the number of signatures required on nomination petitions for City elections; and

WHEREAS, the City find that the adoption of the alternative allowed by State law may increase candidate participation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona:

That the number of signatures required on nomination petitions for a candidate for the office of mayor or council shall be one thousand (1000) signature or at least five percent (5%) but not more than ten percent (10%) of the vote for mayor in the last preceding election at which a mayor was elected, whichever is less.
