

RESOLUTION NO. 04-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MARICOPA GRANTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO PURSUE A WASTE REDUCTION ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY TO ASSIST IN ESTABLISHING A RECYCLING AND WASTE REDUCTION PROGRAM OPTION WITHIN THE CITY OF MARICOPA

WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statute § 9-500.07 provides that a city shall provide its residents with an opportunity to engage in recycling and waste reduction; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality provides grant opportunities for cities to provide assistance in establishing a recycling and waste reduction program option within cities; and

WHEREAS, the Waste Reduction Assistance Grant provides an opportunity for the City of Maricopa to provide a recycling and waste reduction program option within the City of Maricopa; and

WHEREAS, the Maricopa City Council believes that it is in the best interests of the City to obtain a Waste Reduction Assistance Grant from the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality to assist the City in providing a recycling and waste reduction program option within the City of Maricopa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Maricopa City Council hereby authorizes the City of Maricopa Grants Advisory Committee to pursue a Waste Reduction Assistance Grant from the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality. The Maricopa City Council acknowledges that the Waste Reduction Assistance Grant requires a sixty percent (60%) monetary match or in-kind match by the City of Maricopa if it is awarded this grant and that such grant amount can be up to \$200,000.00. The Maricopa City Council hereby further authorizes the City of Maricopa Grants Advisory Committee to pursue partnerships to meet the City's sixty percent (60%) monetary match or in-kind match requirement if it is awarded a Waste Reduction Assistance Grant from the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality.
