**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA REQUESTING THAT THE PINAL COUNTY PRESIDING JUVENILE COURT JUDGE APPOINT THE HONORABLE SCOTT SULLEY AS THE JUVENILE HEARING OFFICER FOR THE CITY OF MARICOPA MUNICIPAL COURT**

**WHEREAS**, the Pinal County Superior Court Presiding Juvenile Court Judge may decline jurisdiction and appoint certain City Court Judges to serve as Juvenile Hearing Officers; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Maricopa Municipal Court needs a Juvenile Hearing Officer and the Honorable Scott Sulley is willing to serve in that capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, the Maricopa City Council believes that it is in the best interests of the City of Maricopa to approve the Honorable Scott Sulley as the Juvenile Hearing Officer for the City of Maricopa.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Maricopa City Council hereby requests that the Pinal County Superior Court Presiding Juvenile Court Judge appoint the Honorable Scott Sulley to serve in the capacity of Juvenile Hearing Officer for the City of Maricopa Municipal Court to process, adjudicate and dispose of all cases in which a child under the age of eighteen (18) years on the date of the alleged offense is charged with violating any of the laws as set forth in A.R.S. §8-323(B), with the exception of driving under the influence, unless specifically approved by the Pinal County Superior Court Presiding Juvenile Court Judge on a case by case basis.
