

RESOLUTION NO. 05-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, INSTRUCTING ITS DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO NO LONGER ACCEPT THE VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS FOR TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED BY RESOLUTION 04-13

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2004 the Mayor and Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, enacted Resolution No. 04-13, which authorized its Development Services Department to accept a Voluntary Transportation Improvement Contribution effective July 1, 2004 to help fund expected improvements necessary to maintain and improve the City of Maricopa's transportation infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maricopa's Development Services Department has, since that time, accepted voluntary contributions from those residential developers who have recognized the need for the City to have funds available to meet the future costs of improvements to the City of Maricopa's transportation infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maricopa has set those contributions aside in a separate fund to help meet the expected future costs to improve the City's transportation infrastructure; and


WHEREAS, despite the voluntary nature of these contributions, some *confusion* concerning the nature of the contributions has arisen with some of the City's residential developers; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Maricopa believe it to be in the best interest of the City to avoid such confusion and attempt to address the City's transportation infrastructure needs through other means;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA;


That the City Council hereby instructs that, effective April 2, 2005, the City's Development Services Department no longer accept the Voluntary Transportation Improvement Contribution from developers submitting residential building permit requests after April 1, 2005.


