RESOLUTION NO. 06-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA URGING THE STATE LEGISLATURE TO ADD LANGUAGE TO TITLE 9 CHAPTER 4 TO ALLOW A MUNICIPALITY TO DELINEATE ON A MAP SPECIFIC LAND FOR FUTURE RIGHTS OF WAY

WHEREAS, the purpose of a master Right of Way map is to allow for public disclosure of future rights of way to be presented to property owners prior to purchasing property; and

WHEREAS, the effect of this potential legislation would be reduced costs and a more efficient and expedient process overall when acquiring property for rights of way; and

WHEREAS, inclusion of this language in existing statutes would allow a fast growing city the opportunity to strategically plan for long-term transportation needs; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe that this potential legislation will benefit the City of Maricopa in its efforts to strategically plan for long-term transportation needs and to notify future property owners of possible future rights of way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, that the City is hereby urging the State Legislature to add language to Title 9 Chapter 4 to allow a municipality to delineate on a map specific land for future Rights of Way.
