A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA URGING THE STATE LEGISLATURE TO CHANGE THE SCHOOL DISTRICT FORMULA FOR FUNDING SCHOOLS AND UTILIZE THE STUDENT PROPULATION RATHER THAN THE ACTUAL POPULATION FOR CALCULATION PURPOSES


WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution is to provide adequate public funding to allow schools to be connected in a timelier manner; and

WHEREAS, the effect of this potential legislation will be to reduce the ratio of students per teacher and reduce the number of students being bussed to other area schools; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe that this potential legislation will benefit the City of Maricopa in its efforts to have adequate school facilities to ensure quality education for its citizens.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, that the City is hereby urging the State Legislature to change the school district formula for funding schools and to utilize student population rather than actual population for calculation purposes.
