## **RESOLUTION NO. 07-34**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, that the said estimates of revenues and expenditures/expenses shown on the accompanying schedules, as now increased, reduced, or changed are hereby adopted as the budget of the City of Maricopa for the fiscal year 2007-2008.
