

RESOLUTION NO. 07-51

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, ALLOWING THE EXPENDITURE OF TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES TO PARTIALLY FUND THE PURCHASE OF TWO ELGIN BROOM BEAR STREET SWEEPERS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$180,000.

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the purchase of street sweepers for the Public Works Department as part of the budget adoption for Fiscal Year 2008;

WHEREAS, the street sweepers will be used by the Public Works Department to provide services within the city; and

WHEREAS, the street sweepers are not being paid for from the general fund and need to be paid for from the Development Impact Fees for Fiscal Year 2008; and

WHEREAS, Transportation Development Impact Fees, in an amount of \$180,000, are available from Transportation Impact Fee #1 Fund 324 pursuant to Chapter 17 of the Maricopa City Code; and


WHEREAS, the City Council believes that appropriating Transportation Development Impact Fees for the purchase of one (1) Elgin Broom Bear Street Sweeper will be in the City's best interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona as follows:

Transportation Development Impact Fees in the amount of One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000) shall be appropriated from Transportation Development Impact Fee #3 Fund 322 for the purchase of one (1) Elgin Broom Bear Street Sweeper from Norwood Equipment Company of Phoenix.




