

RESOLUTION NO. 20-43

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY IN SUPPORT OF FUNDING FOR THE MARICOPA FAMILY ADVOCACY CENTER HEALTHCARE AND OPERATION EXPENSES.

WHEREAS, the Gila River Indian Community administers a grant program which provides proposition 202 Indian Gaming funds to cities, towns and counties for government services that benefit the general public in the areas of public safety, transportation, health care, economic development and education; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maricopa encourages and supports the preservation and promotion of a safe, secure environment through the investigation of crimes against persons and public safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maricopa has adopted a Strategic Plan that includes community safety as a priority; and

WHEREAS, the Maricopa Police Department will prepare a grant application for the submission to the Gila River Indian Community requesting funds to be used to for healthcare and operation expenses for the Maricopa Family Advocacy Center.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona as follows:

Section 1: The Maricopa City Council hereby approves the submission of an application for Gila River Indian Community State Shared Revenue Program funds in the amount of \$37,881 to be used for health care and operation expenses for the Maricopa Family Advocacy Center.

Section 2: The Maricopa City Council hereby authorizes staff to execute the grant application and transmit the application materials and supporting documentation as approved by the Maricopa Police Department / Family Advocacy Center to the Gila River Indian Community.

Section 3: The City of Maricopa agrees to accept any grant funds awarded by the Gila River Indian Community pursuant to this application and upon receipt to transmit such funds to the Maricopa Finance Department for disbursement to the Maricopa Police Department / Family Advocacy Center.

Section 4: The City's submission of the grant application and disbursement of any grant funds received to the Maricopa Police Department / Family Advocacy Center is expressly conditioned on compliance with all appropriate procedures, guidelines and requirements of the grant, including but not limited to, financial disclosure and program related reports to the Gila River Indian Community.


