

RESOLUTION NO. 22-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AK CHIN INDIAN COMMUNITY FOR THE MARICOPA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND AGREEING TO ACT AS THE DESIGNATED FISCAL AGENT OF SUCH FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Ak Chin Indian Community disburses grant money to non profit agencies within a broad spectrum of services and programs that serve the general public; and

WHEREAS, in order to be eligible to receive funding from the Ak Chin Indian Community, a local non-profit must show that the City of Maricopa will act as a fiscal agent and accept funding on behalf on the non-profit 's behalf; and


WHEREAS, Maricopa Unified School District has a special tax status that supports academic success, good character and citizenship and healthy lifestyles; and


